1. Ld. Addl. PP submits that since the convicts herein have exhausted all their legal remedies, therefore, this court may proceed ahead with fixing the date for execution of death sentence.
2. Ld. Legal Aid Counsel Sh. Ravi Qazi fairly concedes that all the available legal remedies have already been exhausted by convict Mukesh and as such there is no statutory impediment warranting this court not to proceed ahead u/s 413/414 CrPC.
3. Ld. counsel Dr A. P. Singh, on behalf of convict Pawan, Vinay and Akshay submits that he would be meeting convict Pawan today in the jail and would thereafter exercise his legal remedies against the rejection of mercy petition of condemned convict Pawan. It is further submitted that he also wants to meet convict Akshay to discuss about the future course of action, however, he fairly concedes that as on date, there is no legal impediment upon the powers of this court to proceed ahead u/s 413/414 CrPC. He prays that jail authorities be directed to permit the convicts to meet with their counsels.

It is further prayed that the jail officials be directed to apprise convict Akshay/his counsel regarding the fate of his second

mercy petition.

4. Needless to say, the Jail Superintendent is duty bound to apprise convict Akshay about the action initiated by the jail authorities upon his petitions/representations.
5. As far as the meeting of the Ld. counsel with their clients is concerned, they are at liberty to meet them as per the standard procedure of jail, after complying with the formalities.
6. It is fairly conceded at bar by the Ld. counsel for the convicts as well as Ld. Addl. PP for the State that as of now, there is no statutory bar in exercise of powers u/s 413/414 CrPC rather it is obligatory on the part of this court to discharge the duties cast upon it under the relevant provisions.
7. In view of the same, it is hereby directed that the death warrants, as issued by this court vide order dated 07.01.2020 in respect of the condemned convicts namely Mukesh, Pawan, Akshay and Vinay shall now be carried into effect by causing the said convicts to be hanged by the neck until they are dead on **20.03.2020 at 5.30 a.m.**
8. Application of the State accordingly stands disposed off.
9. Copy of this order be served upon the convicts as well as their respective counsels as necessary information.
10. Copy of this order be also given dasti to Ld. Counsel for the victims and also to the jail authorities for necessary information and compliance.
11. File be consigned to Record Room.
