Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that her services as a Instructor (Arts Education), made in terms of the Government Order dated 31.01.2013, under a contract appointment dated 31.01.2013, have not been renewed in breach of the provisions of paragraph No.6 of the Government Order dated 31.01.2013. Paragraph No.6(3) of the Government Order under reference mentions that where part time Instructor's services are not found fit, their assessment is to be recorded and services are not to be dispensed with suddenly; rather, opportunity of improvement is to be given. Here, it is argued that the petitioner's services were not extended after May 2019, without assignment of any reason to the knowledge of the petitioner or following the procedure prescribed under paragraph No.6 of the Government Order dated 31.01.2013.

Mr. Durga Singh, Advocate appears on behalf of respondent No.2. Mr. Satish Chandra Yadav, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.4 and the learned Standing Counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 3. All the learned counsel representing the respondents are granted two weeks time to file a counter affidavit, specifically clarifying whether any reasons have been

recorded for declining to renew the petitioner's engagement in accordance with the provisions of paragraph No.6 of the Government Order dated 31.01.2013. The required records shall be annexed to the counter affidavit to be filed on behalf of one or the other respondents, whoever has possession of it.
