- 3. Words from *dent*(Sanskrit)=tooth(English) because it *tooth*=breaks.....
- 4. Dent(a Sanskrit word : dent- manjan is used for dental powder):dent(in English) is bang and from a dent(a tooth) and in dental : AL stands for Abraham Lincoln being bad oral hygienic (in Oral also AL stands for Abraham Lincoln) : dent(bang) can be caused by dent(tooth) : a scar on a hard metal substance as like done by a strong object like by a tooth.Oracura+oral+cure: a company name dealing in oral hygiene.
